

The History of the West Side Nut Club

Prologue

In the early 1900's, the West Side Businessmen were striving to find ways to increase exposure and bring more people to the West Franklin Street area. Access to the West Side was very difficult and time consuming, especially from the West and North outlying areas, because no main roads leading to Franklin Street were available.

These enterprising and hard working businessmen, all of whom were members of the West Side Business Association, held small Festivals in 1914, 1917 & 1920 to try to attract people to their stores. They met daily for lunch and decided that they needed an organized group to use their influence to make improvements to the West Side and to handle the duties of running the Festivals.

West Side Nut Club Formed

On March 16, 1921 this group of businessmen met and formed the basics of the West Side Nut Club. Within the first 6 months, they elected officers &board members, named the club, incorporated and wrote the by-laws, selected the Acorn as the symbol and penned the official slogan: Root, Boost or Scoot. The first official WSNC Fall Festival was heldin November; it was considered a great success but left them with \$400 in debt. In order to pay off the debt, they assessed each member \$10.

Over the first 25 years, the club struggled through the Great Depression and World War II. With little or no money, they used their influence to persuade the city to build a new bridge on Franklin Street and to put the new municipal Golf course and Mesker Park Zoo on the West Side. They kept pressuring the city and county to pave the dirt and rock streets and roads and to extend St. Joseph Ave. north into the county.

During the second 25 years, the Club started prospering and expanded the Festival into what it is today. Food booths increased as did donations to non-profit groups. Queen and Amateur contests and professional entertainment were added. Membership was expanded to 300 active members and the Board was expanded also.

1971 to Present, revenues & donations have continued to increase astronomically. Spring Projects were started, the first of which were clean-ups of Franklin St., Mesker Park Zoo, Reitz Hill and West Side Library Park.

Later, the Club started performing larger construction projects. Shelter houses, rest rooms and ball fields were constructed at West Side Little League, Golfmoor, Tekoppel, Moutoux and Junior Football League fields. Sidewalks and landscaping were developed or improved on Franklin Street and at West Side Library Park. Several large projects were performed at Mesker Park Zoo, Helfrich Golf Course, USI, Ozanam Family Shelter and Reitz High School. With the Club performing at least one project every year, we have been able to perform many more projects than what are listed above. Each project costs approximately \$25,000, plus 75 to 100 members donating their time and talent.

2023

This year, the West Side Nut Club donated over \$100,000 worth of work to Hillcrest Family Services during the annual spring project. Thanks to a successful 2022 Fall Festival and 50-50 Half Pot, the club will donate approximately \$800,000 to charitable and/or non-profit organizations during 2023. As of May 2023, the West Side Nut Club has donated close to \$9 MILLION dollars back into the community since its creation.

Dan was born and raised in South Bend, Indiana and was the oldest of four children to Jerry and Gloria Egierski. After graduating from South Bend LaSalle High School in 1974, he attended Holy Cross Junior College in South Bend before transferring to the University of Evansville in 1976.

Dan graduated from the University of Evansville in 1978 with a degree in Interpersonal Communications and began his broadcasting career in January of 1979 in Tell City, Indiana where he worked broadcasting high school football, basketball, baseball and softball.

Dan began a 36 year career in Evansville in May, 1986 when he accepted a job at WGBF broadcasting high school football and basketball games and a handful of University of Southern Indiana Men's Basketball games. Dan became the full time voice of USI Men's Basketball in 1992 until his retirement following the 2022 season. During his broadcasting career, Dan was the voice of Evansville high school football, boys and girls basketball, baseball and soccer as well as the University of Evansville baseball in the 90's and was the first voice of the Evansville Otters beginning in 1995. Dan also spent 3 years as the voice of the Evansville Blue Cats indoor football team.

Dan has had the opportunity to call games involving some of the best athletes ever to play in Evansville including Don Mattingly, Andy Benes, Calbert Chaney, Kevin Hardy, Deke Cooper and even did a swim meet where Olympic champion Lilly King competed.

Dan has also had the opportunity to be behind the microphone for some of the biggest games in our city's history both at the high school level as well as the University of Southern Indiana Men's Basketball program.

Dan has been honored several times for his broadcasting work by the state of Indiana including being the first radio announcer in Evansville to win the Marv Bates award in 2010 and was inducted into the Indiana Sportswriters and Sportscasters Association Hall of Fame in 2017. Dan is also in the Evansville Sports Hall of Fame for football, basketball and baseball.

Dan has been coming to the Fall Festival since his arrival in Evansville in 1986 and cherishes his relationship with several of the Nut Club members.

Dan resides in Newburgh with his wife Cindy and has two grown children, Ryan who lives in Carmel, Indiana with his wife Natalie and Lauren who resides in Prosper, Texas with her husband Kevin.

Dan and Cindy are blessed to be the grandparents of Charlie, Mickey, Elizabeth, Montgomery and Cozette who will arrive in December.
